**Resolution In Support of National Grandparents Day
September 9, 2008**

WHEREAS, grandparents represent our heritage and are essential members of our families and communities and National Grandparent's Day is set aside every year to honor grandparents; and

WHEREAS, the impetus for a National Grandparents Day originated with Marian McQuade, a housewife in Fayette County, West Virginia. Her primary motivation was to champion the cause of lonely elderly in nursing homes and persuade grandchildren to tap the wisdom and experience of their grandparents; and

WHEREAS, former President Jimmy Carter in 1978 proclaimed that National Grandparents Day would be celebrated every year on the first Sunday after Labor Day; and

WHEREAS, National Grandparents Day is a family day for which schools, churches and senior organizations honor grandparents with special events that will enhance intergenerational interaction; and

WHEREAS, National Grandparents Day offers grandparents quality time with their grandchildren, while providing grandchildren an opportunity to share in the history of their family and encourages grandchildren to gain new awareness and respect for older persons; and

WHEREAS, we should not forget "shut-ins" and those in nursing homes who are unable to be with their families or have no families. Every effort must be made to include these people in the mainstream through cards, community projects, and visitations at times other than just holidays; and


WHEREAS, we are very fortunate to have many Foster Grandparents in our schools to help our students with academics and share their wisdom, experience and talents with our students.
