1	<b>Rule A - General Rules (Exhibit "B"):</b> Modifies Cost Recovery requirements to enable a minimum charge of two (2%) percent or the percentage that a credit/debit card company charges the District for credit or debit card transactions pertaining to Cost Recovery matters.	The change is a component of ongoing District staff efforts to establish an on-line payment mechanism that would allow developers or their agents to make payments via credit or debit cards for matters relating to the submission, processing and review of residential development applications.
4-5	<b>Rule B -</b> Deletes the word "permanent" as it relates to capacity, and added language which indicates that capacity as referenced in the Subsection shall be consistent with the effective capacity utilized in the review of public school concurrency (PSC) determination.  Additional language in the Subsection also states that an applicant proposing residential development may voluntarily offer to mitigate the student impact anticipated from such development if sufficient capacity is available to accommodate the student(s) at the impacted schools.	To enable consistency with the implementation of the 100% gross Level of Service Standard (LOS) capacity.  To provide flexibility in the voluntary mitigation program called for in the Subsection.
6-10	<b>Rule C -</b> Added language to reflect amendment of the LOS from 110% permanent FISH capacity to 100% gross capacity, and sunset the use of relocatables in the year 2018. Also added language regarding utilization of the new LOS in PSC determination.	To enable consistency with the Second Amended ILA, and regarding the utilization of the new LOS in PSC determination.
11, 17	Housekeeping updates to timeframes as required by changes contained in the Second Amended ILA, and titles to reflect changes in the District's organizational chart.	To enable consistency with the Second Amended ILA and to reflect current titles in the 2010-11 District organizational chart.
