## THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA

(Hereafter referred to as SBBC), a body corporate and political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose principal place of business is 600 Southeast Third Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301

and

#### **BROWARD COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

(hereafter referred to as BC), a political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose principal place of business is 225 East Las Olas Blvd, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301

and

## FLORIDA ATLANTIC UNIVERSITY BOARD OF TRUSTEES

(hereafter referred to as FAU) whose principal place of business is 777 Glades Road, Boca Raton, Florida 33431

WHEREAS, BC, FAU and SBBC are required by Section 1007.235, Florida Statutes to enter into an Interinstitutional Agreement; and

WHEREAS, BC, FAU and SBBC desire to ratify all existing articulation agreements; and

WHEREAS, BC, FAU AND SBBC offer courses and programs which will enhance accelerated learning opportunities, including dual enrollment for qualified Broward County high school students; and

WHEREAS, SBBC wishes to promote and explain eligibility criteria for participation in accelerated learning opportunities to students and parents, including dual enrollment, and explain the process by which students and parents can exercise their option to participate; and

WHEREAS, BC, FAU and SBBC have implemented strategies for reducing the incidence of Post-secondary remediation in math, reading, and writing for first-time enrolled recent high school graduates; and

WHEREAS, BC and SBBC are a part of the Broward County Career Pathways Consortium and collaboratively promote and implement the Career & Technical Education/Career Pathways Program; and

WHEREAS, BC and SBBC have developed mechanisms and strategies FICLOSURE the preparation of elementary, middle and high school teachers; and

WHEREAS, the components of this agreement are aligned with A++ legislation requiring middle school students to complete a semester course in career and education planning and high school students to select a High School Major Area of Interest.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

## **ARTICLE 1 – RECITALS**

1.01 <u>Recitals.</u> The Parties agree that the foregoing recitals are true and correct and that such recitals are incorporated herein by reference.

## **ARTICLE 2 – SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

- 2.01 <u>Term of Agreement.</u> The term of this Agreement shall commence on August 21, 2010 and shall be effective through August 21, 2015 unless terminated by any party pursuant to this Agreement. Any party to this Agreement shall have the right to terminate this Agreement by delivery of written notice to the other parties not less than ninety (90) days prior to the effective date of said termination.
- **2.02 Joint Responsibilities.** SBBC, BC and FAU shall maintain responsibility for implementing the various components of this Agreement as delineated in Articles 3, 4, 6, and 7 of this Agreement. SBBC, BC and FAU shall review this Agreement and performance of parties hereunder each year to ensure that it continues to serve their mutual interests.
- **2.03** <u>Indemnification.</u> To the extent permitted by law, each party agrees to be fully responsible for its acts of negligence or its agent's acts of negligence when acting within the scope of their employment and agrees to be liable for any damages resulting from said negligence.

## **ARTICLE 3– RATIFICATION OF ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS**

- **3.01** Ratification. To attest to the strong partnership between BC, FAU, and SBBC, the following existing articulation agreements are hereby ratified by the parties
  - Broward Education Consortium
  - Teaching Leadership Center @FAU
  - Career & Technical Education/Career Pathways Articulation Agreements
- 3.02 <u>Articulation Committee.</u> SBBC, BC, and FAU shall participate in an articulation committee which shall make recommendations regarding the dual enrollment classes and other aspects of this Agreement. Committee members shall include:
  - Deputy Superintendent, Curriculum (Co-Chair, SBBC)

#### **ARTICLE 4 - DUAL ENROLLMENT**

- Program Description. Accelerated mechanisms include programs in which eligible 4.01 home education, public and non-public high school students are permitted to enroll in a postsecondary course creditable toward a high school diploma, a vocational/technical certificate, or an associate or baccalaureate degree. Accelerated programs include: dual enrollment, technical dual enrollment, early admissions, Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, and CLEP. Dual enrollment, an articulated acceleration mechanism between SBBC, BC and FAU, shall serve to shorten the time necessary for students to complete the requirements associated with the conference of a degree, broaden the scope of curricular options available to students, and increase the depth of study in a student's major area of interest by offering co-sponsored college credit courses to eligible high school students as provided in the Interinstitutional Articulation Agreement. Credits and grade points will be assigned according to policies established by BC, FAU, and SBBC. The SBBC must weigh dual enrollment courses the same as advanced placement, International Baccalaureate, and Advanced International Certificate of Education courses when grade point averages are calculated. Alternative grade calculation, weighting systems that discriminate against dual enrollment courses are prohibited (F.S. 1007.271). BC and FAU agree to permit high school students enrolled in eligible home education, public and non-public high schools in Broward County, who have been certified by their principals and qualified, to dually enroll in regularly offered courses listed in the approved dual credit course list attached hereto as Appendix A, under the provisions of Florida Statutes, applicable state rules or regulation, and the following terms and conditions of this agreement.
- 4.02 <u>Programs of Study.</u> Students may enroll in general education and elective courses within the AA degree program or the career/technical education programs of study that are not available at their high school. Career/technical dual enrollment shall be available for secondary students seeking a degree or certificate from a complete career preparatory program at the technical center or college, and shall not be used to enroll students in isolated career courses.
- 4.03 <u>Course Credit.</u> Students eligible for dual enrollment shall be permitted to enroll in dual enrollment courses conducted during school hours, after school hours and during the summer term. Each course taught on a high school campus involved in the dual enrollment program must maintain a minimum of fifteen (15) and a maximum of twenty-five (25) students. Students enrolled in dual enrollment courses shall earn both high school credit from SBBC and college credit from BC or FAU if they meet the minimum requirements for satisfactory completion of such courses. Students who complete a three (3) four (4) or five (5) credit dual enrollment course at BC or FAU with a

passing grade (C or better) will earn the corresponding high school credit as delineated in Appendix

A.

- 4.04 <u>Guidance Services.</u> The guidance department at the high school has the responsibility of advising the students as to course offerings, providing the confidential recommendation form for admissions, indicating the specific course(s) in which eligible students are to be enrolled. In regard to college degree requirements, all students enrolled in an accelerated program will be encouraged to take advantage of the advising services at BC and Florida's online student advising system found at <a href="https://www.FACTS.org">www.FACTS.org</a>. BC and SBBC may provide personally identifiable student records to each other in the performance of this agreement. Such records are provided pursuant to Sections 1002.22 and 1002.221 Florida Statutes, and 20 U.S.C. 1232g. Each party further agrees to comply with Sections 1002.22 and 1002.221, Florida Statutes, and 20 U.S.C. 1232g, including but not limited to provisions related to confidentiality, access, consent, length of retention and security of student records.
- 4.05 Recruitment Procedures. Each high school will provide students and families with informational documents describing the educational benefits and eligibility requirements for the various program acceleration mechanisms. Each high school curriculum guide will describe acceleration mechanisms. On an annual basis, the school district will notify the parents of rising 9<sup>th</sup> graders regarding the importance of rigorous coursework such as Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment courses. In a cooperative effort, admissions and registration personnel from BC will be available to local area high schools to provide additional information and answer specific questions students may have. Dual enrollment information will be included in SBBC's middle school career education course.
- 4.06 Registration Procedures for High School Dual Enrollment at BC. The admissions and registration officials at the BC campus in the area of participating high schools will provide appropriate forms and will work jointly with the designated high school guidance staff to accomplish application and registration requirements. A home education dual enrollment student must be registered with SBBC. Students wishing to retake a course must go through a review process and present appropriate documentation.

Students must submit the following documents to the campus Admissions Office prior to registration.

- A. A completed application for admission to an accelerated program. The current application fee will be waived.
- B. A confidential recommendation form signed by the high school principal or designee.
- C. Test scores for ACT, SAT or the Florida Entry Level Placement Test (CPT).
- D. An official copy of the transcript will be provided by the high school for purpose of advising, counseling, and GPA verification.
- 4.07 Registration Procedures for High School Dual Enrollment at FAU.

Students must submit the following documents to the Registrar's Office prior to registration.

- A. A completed Dual Enrollment Application and Residency Form located on the Dual Enrollment website.
- B. Test scores for ACT, SAT, or the Florida Entry Level Placement Test (CPT). High School GPA verification.
- C. Broward County Dual Enrollment Authorization/ Permission form.
- D. FAU Immunization form and records.
- 4.08 <u>Withdrawal Procedures.</u> High school students are responsible for completing the proper paperwork and notifying their high school counselor if they choose to withdraw from a course. The BC/FAU academic calendars provide the information concerning the withdrawal dates.
- Eligibility Criteria. BC and FAU agree to permit high school students in eligible home education, public and nonpublic high schools in Broward County, who have been certified by their principals as qualified, to dually enroll in courses listed and described in Appendix A and/or FAU's undergraduate catalog as approved under the provisions of Florida Statutes. Students who have completed 11 credits prior to the fall term and 13.5 credits prior to the winter term may be concurrently enrolled at Broward College in post-secondary courses creditable toward a vocational certificate, diploma, or an associate, or baccalaureate degree provided they meet program rules and regulations. Students participating in dual enrollment options must meet the following minimum entrance eligibility requirements: (1) enrolled in a course of study which will fulfill requirements for high school graduation; (2) 3.0 cumulative unweighted GPA and; (3) minimum standardized college placement score. Students may not earn more than 12 credits of dual enrollment unless they have passed all three sections of the CPT or have appropriate SAT/ACT scores. For specific placement information, students should refer to the institution's catalog, testing website or visit a campus testing center. Minimum placement requirements are based upon State Board of Education Rule 6A-10.0315 on College Preparatory Testing, Placement, and Instruction and/or the Board of Governor's Regulation 6.002 on Admission of Undergraduate First-Time-in-College, Degree-Seeking Freshmen. Students may enroll in a maximum of 11 dual enrollment credits per semester. Students with appropriate minimum placement exam scores may enroll in the Student Life Skills course, SLS1001, only.

College Academy students are subject to additional eligibility criteria as published by the College Academy. In order to continue in the program, students must maintain a 3.0 unweighted grade point average (GPA) in their high school academic work and earn a 2.0 ("C") or better in college-level work as confirmed by their high school guidance director and BC/FAU's registrar's office. College Academy students are subject to alternative criteria for continuing in the program as published by the College Academy. The 11 dual enrollment credit limit per semester does not apply to College Academy students.

Early Admission, a form of dual enrollment, allows eligible senior students to enter BC/FAU as a freshman instead of attending high school for the senior year. After the student completes their freshman year at BC/FAU, they will need to submit their final high school transcript showing the graduation date. For BC, eligibility criteria for Early Admission are the same as stated above for dual enrollment. For FAU, eligibility criteria for Early Admission are (1) a 3.5 or better GPA after six semesters of high school, (2) an SAT score of 1800 or an ACT score of 27, (3) permission from their

high school to allow FAU courses to satisfy any remaining requirements toward high school graduation, (4) written recommendations attesting to the student's maturity and readiness to meet the academic and personal challenges by early entry into higher education, and (5) Florida residency.

The home education dual enrollment student is only required to meet the same placement scores as an SBBC student. Home education dual enrollment students may participate in the dual enrollment program at BC for two consecutive years of academic instruction or until the end of the term in which the student reaches the age of 19. After the two consecutive years are completed or the student turns 19 (whichever occurs first), the home education student may not be admitted to BC as a dual enrollment student unless otherwise provided by law.

- Code of Conduct. Dual Enrollment students are responsible for following the BC or FAU student code of conduct which outlines acceptable and unacceptable behavior for BC or FAU students as well as appropriate disciplinary procedures and sanctions.
- 4.11 Course and Program Quality. All dual enrollment courses taught on the high school campus will be limited to registered dual enrolled students whose applications have been accepted by BC or FAU. High school students who have not been admitted by BC or FAU may not be included in the dual enrollment course. Appropriate SBBC and BC or FAU staff shall meet and confer to recommend qualified faculty for dual enrollment classes. Preference will be given to high school teachers in the selection process. All faculties must meet or exceed the academic and professional preparation requirements for teaching at BC or FAU. As an example, faculty teaching general education courses must have completed at least eighteen (18) graduate semester hours in the teaching discipline and have at least a master's degree; faculties teaching technical education and other transferrable courses typically have completed a baccalaureate degree with appropriate work experience. BC/FAU shall appoint all instructors. BC/FAU will evaluate instruction and monitor student performance in all dual enrollment classes using the same criteria for judging instructional quality as in effect in all classes offered at the college/university.
- Reporting Compliance. SBBC shall maintain the electronic exchange of student transcripts and associated educational records, including acquisition of and access to test scores of students in the standard format established by the Articulation Coordinating Committee (ACC) to the Commissioner in accordance with Rule 6A-10.024 (12), FAC.
- Responsibilities for Costs. BC, FAU, and SBBC warrant and agree that all dual enrollment programs shall meet the provisions of the current State of Florida laws and regulations. BC, FAU, and SBBC shall establish cost-sharing budgetary procedures to support specialized dual enrollment programs which will include the following provisions:
  - A. Students enrolled in dual enrollment may be included in the calculation of full-time student membership for basic program grades 9-12 by SBBC.
  - B. Students enrolled in dual enrollment instruction may be counted as full-time equivalent by BC/FAU.
  - C. Students receiving instruction under the provisions of this Agreement shall be exempt from the payment of BC/FAU registration, matriculation, and laboratory fees. Instructional materials for dual enrollment courses will be provided to SBBC high school

students free of charge by their SBBC high school. Home education and non-public school students are required to purchase textbooks.

- D. BC/FAU will pay for the cost of the instructor for all dual enrollment courses taught by college faculty at a BC/FAU campus. SBBC will pay for the cost of instructors for courses taught by SBBC faculty on an SBBC high school campus.
- E. Transportation: BC/FAU Dual enrolled students will be responsible for providing his/her own transportation.
- F. FAU Dual Enrollment students are required to pay a one-time Owl Card fee and a Parking and Transportation fee (each semester) that is not included in registration, tuition, or laboratory fees.

When a student with special needs has been accepted into the dual enrollment program at BC, the Office of Disability Services will cover the cost for and provide the ESE/ADA accommodations determined necessary for the student according to the students Individual Education Plan (IEP) for the dual enrollment course for which the student is enrolled.

**4.14** <u>Transportation.</u> All students must provide their own transportation. College Academy students may utilize SBBC and/or public transportation subject to the conditions published by the College Academy.

## ARTICLE 5 – COLLEGE ACADEMY

5.01 <u>Program Overview.</u> The College Academy is a special case of dual enrollment program for selected high school students on the central campus of BC. Students who have earned 14 high school credits will be eligible for admission into the College Academy based on the criteria published by the College Academy which meets or exceeds all approved dual enrollment criteria. The College Academy offers its students the opportunity to receive a high school diploma from the SBBC and an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from BC concurrently. College Academy students and faculty follow the BC calendar. College Academy students must adhere to the rules and regulations of both BC and SBBC.

## ARTICLE 6 - CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION/CAREER PATHWAYS

6.01 Program Overview. Career & Technical Education/Career Pathways provides an opportunity for students to engage in a rigorous curriculum that integrates academic and technical education competencies; learning experiences utilize applied learning strategies associated with specific careers as well as articulated post secondary education opportunities. Through numerous programmatic articulation agreements, students are granted college credits for high school coursework, thus saving them time and money in their pursuit of a postsecondary certificate or degree. Together both institutions work collaboratively in marketing programs, recruiting students, providing staff development, transitioning students, evaluating programs, and assessing results. The programmatic articulation agreements are aligned with and enhance statewide articulation agreements.

6.02 Program Articulation. Career & Technical Education/Career Pathways programs provide a seamless transition from high school to postsecondary education. Programmatic articulation agreements have been developed and implemented in the technical education curriculum areas of: agriscience & natural resources, business technology, family & consumer science, health science, industrial, marketing, public service and technology education. Appendix B identifies the list of program articulation agreements, including the possible number of credits to be awarded.

## ARTICLE 7 – POST-SECONDARY REMEDIATION REDUCTION

- 7.01 <u>Reduction of Remediation.</u> BC and SBBC agree to devise and monitor a plan that addresses the issue of reducing postsecondary remediation.
  - A. BC and SBBC will delineate specific curricular paths to be offered all high school students flagged in the SBBC system as needing remediation for college. (Students without appropriate entrance exam scores and appropriate GPA may enroll in the BC for the Student Life Skills course only.)
  - B. BC will maintain data on remedial students and track their progress after attending remedial programs and after high school graduation if they choose to enroll at BC.
  - C. BC will make available to SBBC schools' 11<sup>th</sup> grade students, who indicate an interest in postsecondary education and score at Level 2 or Level 3 on the reading portion of the grade 10 FCAT or at level 2, Level 3, or Level 4 on the mathematics portion of the FCAT, a college-readiness assessment (CPT) by the end of their junior year. The CPT will be offered at public high schools. Training will be provided to the SBBC personnel who will administer the CPT by BC personnel.
  - D. SBBC will offer Math for College Success (Course Code Directory course number: 1200410) which closely aligns to the non-college credit, postsecondary developmental course Elementary Algebra, MAT 0024, to students scoring below "72" on the mathematics section of the CPT, below "440" on the SAT mathematics section, or below "19" on the ACT mathematics section. This course will receive ½ high school elective credit only.
  - E. SBBC will also offer Math for College Readiness (Course Code Directory course number 1200700 which closely aligns to the college credit postsecondary course, Intermediate Algebra. This course is most appropriate for students scoring between "72-83" on the mathematics section of the CPT.
  - F. There is currently no standardized state exit exam for Mathematics for College Readiness; however, there is a required final exam for BC. In order to be eligible for subsequent enrollment in College Algebra at BC, students will need to successfully complete this course with a grade of "C" or better, and achieve a score greater than "86" on CPT/Accuplacer, or score "520" or greater on the SAT mathematics section or "22" or greater on the ACT mathematics section. To exempt any further assessment and/or

prerequisite requirements, students must enroll in College Algebra within two (2) years of completing Mathematics for College Readiness.

- G. SBBC will offer Writing for College Success (Course Code Directory course number: 1009370) which closely aligns to the non-college credit, postsecondary developmental course College Preparatory Writing, ENC 0021, to students scoring below "83" on the English section of the CPT, below "440" on the SAT English section, or below "17" on the ACT English section. This course will receive ½ high school elective credit only.
- H. SBBC will offer Reading for College Success (Course Code Directory course number: 1608350) which closely aligns to the non-college credit, postsecondary developmental course College Preparatory Reading II, REA 0006, to students scoring below "83" on the Reading section of the CPT, below "440" on the SAT Reading section, or below "17" on the ACT Reading section. This course will receive ½ high school elective credit only.
- I. Per Section 1008.30, Florida Statutes, successful completion of college preparatory curriculum requires a passing score on a standardized state examination. BC shall provide SBBC high schools with the test forms used for MAT 0024, ENC 0021, and REA 0006 students at BC. For test security purposes, BC and SBBC will coordinate exam delivery. SBBC is responsible for administering the exit exam and recording exam grades. BC will provide training to SBBC teachers on holistic grading for the essay portion of the English exit exam.

#### **ARTICLE 8 – TEACHER PREPARATION**

- **8.01** Teacher Preparation. BC, FAU, and SBBC recognize that teacher preparation is a high priority for each institution and as such have developed the following programs for improving teacher preparation:
  - A. BC, FAU and SBBC market teaching as a profession through media campaigns.
  - B. BC and FAU have established the joint Secondary Teacher Project which helps to recruit and retain teachers particularly those at the secondary level in English, math, and science.
  - C. BC has established the Education Preparation Institute which will provide instruction for baccalaureate degree holders to become certified teachers through a competency-based alternative certification programs.
  - D. The Broward Teacher Fellowship is a scholarship program designed to help deserving students pursue careers in Education by providing 2 +2 college tuition scholarships to qualified graduates of the Urban Teacher Academy (UTAP) program. UTAP engages students in a structured four-year plan of study to prepare for careers in education.
  - E. BC, FAU, SBBC and several other colleges have enhanced teacher preparation through early field experiences and mentoring programs to strengthen success of preservice students.
  - F. BC, FAU and SBBC collaborate in grant preparation and other funding proposals.

G. BC will offer baccalaureate degrees in the following programs:

- H. The Articulation Committee will develop a teacher preparation plan that identifies opportunities for collaborative efforts in teacher and staff development between BC, FAU, and SBBC.

## **ARTICLE 9 – GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- 9.01 No Waiver of Sovereign Immunity. Nothing herein is intended to serve as a waiver of sovereign immunity by any agency or political subdivision to which sovereign immunity may be applicable or of any rights or limits to liability existing under Section 768.28, Florida Statutes.
- 9.02 No Third Party Beneficiaries. The parties expressly acknowledge that it is not their intent to create or confer any rights or obligations in or upon any third party person or entity under this Agreement. None of the parties intend to directly or substantially benefit a third party by this Agreement. The parties agree that there are no third party beneficiaries to this Agreement and that no third party shall be entitled to assert a claim against any of the parties based upon this Agreement. Nothing herein shall be construed as consent by an agency or political subdivision of the State of Florida to be sued by third parties in any matter arising out of any contract.
- 9.03 <u>Non-Discrimination</u>. The parties shall not discriminate against any employee or participant in the performance of the duties, responsibilities and obligations under this Agreement because of race, age, religion, color, gender, national origin, marital status, disability or sexual orientation.
- 9.04 <u>Termination</u>. This Agreement may be cancelled with or without cause by any party during the term hereof upon ninety (90) days written notice to the other parties of its desire to terminate this Agreement.
- 9.05 Records. Each party shall maintain its own respective records and documents associated with this Agreement in accordance with the records retention requirements applicable to public records. Each party shall be responsible for compliance with any public documents request served upon it pursuant to Section 119.07, Florida Statutes, and any resultant award of attorney's fees for non-compliance with that law.
- 9.06 Entire Agreement. This document incorporates and includes all prior negotiations, correspondence, conversations, agreements and understandings applicable to the matters contained herein and the parties agree that there are no commitments, agreements or understandings concerning the subject matter of this Agreement that are not contained in this document. Accordingly, the parties

agree that no deviation from the terms hereof shall be predicated upon any prior representations or agreements, whether oral or written.

- 9.07 <u>Amendments.</u> No modification, amendment, or alteration in the terms or conditions contained herein shall be effective unless contained in a written document prepared with the same or similar formality as this Agreement and executed by each party hereto.
- 9.08 <u>Preparation of Agreement.</u> The parties acknowledge that they have sought and obtained whatever competent advice and counsel as was necessary for them to form a full and complete understanding of all rights and obligations herein and that the preparation of this Agreement has been their joint effort. The language agreed to herein express their mutual intent and the resulting document shall not, solely as a matter of judicial construction, be construed more severely against one of the parties than the other.
- 9.09 <u>Waiver</u>. The parties agree that each requirement, duty and obligation set forth herein is substantial and important to the formation of this Agreement and, therefore, is a material term hereof. Any party's failure to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver of such provision or modification of this Agreement. A waiver of any breach of a provision of this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver of any subsequent breach and shall not be construed to be a modification of the terms of this Agreement.
- 9.10 <u>Compliance with Laws</u>. Each party shall comply with all applicable federal and state laws, codes, rules and regulations in performing its duties, responsibilities and obligations pursuant to this Agreement.
- 9.11 Governing Law. This Agreement shall be interpreted and construed in accordance with and governed by the laws of the State of Florida. Any controversies or legal problems arising out of this Agreement and any action involving the enforcement or interpretation of any rights hereunder shall be submitted to the jurisdiction of the State courts of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Broward County, Florida.
- 9.12 <u>Binding Effect.</u> This Agreement shall be binding upon and insure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
- 9.13 <u>Assignment.</u> Neither this Agreement nor any interest herein may be assigned, transferred or encumbered by any party without the prior written consent of the other party. There shall be no partial assignments of this Agreement including, without limitation, the partial assignment of any right to receive payments from SBBC, BC or FAU.
- 9.14 Force Majeure. Neither party shall be obligated to perform any duty, requirement or obligation under this Agreement if such performance is prevented by fire, hurricane, earthquake, explosion, wars, sabotage, accident, flood, acts of God, strikes, or other labor disputes, riot or civil commotions, or by reason of any other matter or condition beyond the control of either party, and which cannot be overcome by reasonable diligence and without unusual expense (Force Majeure). In no event shall a lack of funds on the part of either party be deemed Force Majeure.

ENCLOSURE 6-A

- 9.15 <u>Place of Performance.</u> All obligations of SBBC, BC and FAU under the terms of this Agreement are reasonably susceptible of being performed in Broward County, Florida and shall be payable and performable in Broward County, Florida.
- 9.16 <u>Severability.</u> In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, unlawful, unenforceable or void in any respect, the invalidity, illegality, unenforceability or unlawful or void nature of that provision shall not affect any other provision and this Agreement shall be considered as if such invalid, illegal, unlawful, unenforceable or void provision had never been included herein.
- 9.17 Notice. When any of the parties desire to give notice to the other, such notice must be in writing, sent by U.S. Mail, postage prepaid, addressed to the party for whom it is intended at the place last specified; the place for giving notice shall remain such until it is changed by written notice in compliance with the provisions of this paragraph.
