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

SUBJECT: Class Size Categorical Funding, Alternative Reduction Recommendation After Appeals

Pursuant to Section 1003.03(4), F.S., attached is the alternative recommendation for a reduction in class size categorical funding for districts and charter schools that were not in compliance with the law. On November 30, 2010, districts and schools that were not in compliance were notified and given an opportunity to appeal based on the law. This alternative recommendation for the adjustment to the class size categorical funding is based on actual student enrollment in excess of what was funded by the Legislature and data reporting errors that were identified through the district and school appeals. It will be discussed at the State Board of Education meeting on January 18, 2011. Final action regarding the reduction in class size categorical funding will be taken by the Legislative Budget Commission.

You are also reminded that the class size compliance plans should be submitted to Linda Champion as soon as possible. The deadline for submission of the plans is February 15, 2011.
