POSTING OF RFP RECOMMENDATION/TABULATION: Bid Recommendations and Tabulations will be posted in the Supply Management and Logistics Department and www.Demandstar.com on **JULY 27, 2011 @ 3:00 PM**, and will remain posted for 72 hours. Any person desiring to protest the Bid Recommendation/Tabulation shall file, in writing, a notice of protest within 72 hours after the time posted as stated herein, and shall file a formal written protest within ten days after filing the notice of protest. Saturdays, Sundays, legal holidays and days during which the school district administration is closed shall be excluded in the computation of the 72-hour time period. Filings shall be at the office of the Director of Supply Management and Logistics Department, 7720 West Oakland Park Boulevard, Suite 323, Sunrise, Florida 33351. Section 120.57(3)(b), Florida Statutes, states that "The formal written protest shall state with particularity the facts and law upon which the protest is based." Any person who files an action protesting and intended decision shall post with the School Board, at the time of filing the formal written protest, a bond, payable to The School Board of Broward County, Florida, in an amount equal to one percent (1%) of the Board's estimate of the total volume of the contract. Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed by Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, or a failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes.

RFP REJECTION SHEET

Reject proposal from Harmony Development Center. Proposer did not meet the minimum eligibility requirement of Section 4.4.5. Proposer must provide a letter from the administrator of each location at which experience is being relied upon to satisfy the requirements of Section 4.4.3. The letter must state the aftercare program must service at least 100 students at one location. The letter provided from Lauderdale Lakes Middle did not state the number of students serviced.

Reject proposal from KSL Childcare Programs. Proposer did not meet the minimum eligibility requirements of Sections 4.6.3 and 4.6.5. Proposer shall provide a letter from the administrator at each location at which experience is being relied upon and the letter must state the aftercare program must service at least 100 students at one location. The Proposer did not state that their company services at least 100 students at one location and no letters from an administrator at each location indicating summer program service were provided.
