Nova Engineering and Environmental, LLC Although the number of construction projects has been reduced in the Capital Plan, there is an appropriation of approximately \$18,500,000 in various categories including Additions (such as Media Centers and Kitchen/Cafeterias), Remodeling & Renovations, Indoor Air Quality, Safety and ADA. The purpose of requesting authorization to negotiate for these services is to have, in place, Engineers on an as needed basis.
