Scope of Work: The purpose of this Bid is to establish term contracts for procurement of Fire Sprinkler and Fire Suppression services with one main contractor and one alternate contractor, for various fire sprinkler and fire suppression projects, as needed, when needed, to			
meet scheduled and unscheduled project needs as required for Item #2, which is for projects from \$200,000 up to \$1,000,000. The			
contract term shall be for three (3) years in a cumulative amount not to exceed \$4,000,000 each, with an option to renew for one additional year and an additional \$1,000,000 each. In the event the main contractor fails to perform or otherwise cannot meet the projected			
requirements as specified in Document 00410, Bid Form, staff may award projects to the alternate contractor.			
Although the number of construction projects has been reduced in the Capital Plan, there is an appropriation of approximately			
\$13,320,000 in various categories including Additions (such as Media Centers and Kitchen/Cafeterias), Remodeling & Renovations,			
Indoor Air Quality, Safety and ADA for fiscal year 2011-2012. Budgeted for fiscal year 2012-2013 is \$10,150,000 and for fiscal year 2013-2014 is \$6,500,000.
