SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND: <p>The terms and conditions for the operation of a charter school are set forth by the governing board of the charter school and The School Board of Broward County, Florida in a written contractual agreement that constitutes a school's charter. Pursuant to Section 1002.33(7)(b), a school's charter school agreement may be renewed subject to a review and provided that none of the statutory grounds for non-renewal have been documented. The Superintendent's Charter School Review Committee reviewed and analyzed the renewal application from Pompano Charter Middle School, Inc. (Pompano Charter Middle School).</p> <p>It is requested that SBBC approve the renewal of the charter agreement and application for Pompano Charter Middle School, Inc. (Pompano Charter Middle School) for a five-year period.
