SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND: The terms and conditions for the operation of a charter school are set forth by the governing board of the charter school and The School Board of Broward County, Florida in a written contractual agreement that constitutes a school's charter. Pursuant to Section 1002.33(7)(b), a school's charter school agreement may be renewed subject to a review and provided that none of the statutory grounds for non-renewal have been documented. The Superintendent's Charter School Review Committee reviewed and analyzed the renewal application from Sunshine Elementary Charter School, Inc. (Sunshine Elementary Charter School). It is requested that SBBC approve the renewal of the charter agreement and application for Sunshine Elementary Charter School, Inc. (Sunshine Elementary Charter School) for a five-year period. An Executive Summary is attached which specifies the grounds for the five-year renewal.
