REQUESTED ACTION:	Approve the Lease Agreement with Faith United Church of Christ Ft. Lauderdale, Inc.														
SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:	<p>This community based location is one of the off campus sites which will provide classroom space for the Off Campus Learning Centers (OCLC). The OCLC provides a full 24 credit high school diploma, credit recovery/retrieval, and technical school opportunities for students who have dropped out of school or who are at risk of dropping out of school.</p> <p>The current Lease Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida and the Faith United Church of Ft. Lauderdale, Inc. was entered into in August 2009, and would expire on July 31, 2012. This Lease Agreement is for a term of three years with a 90 day cancellation clause by either party.</p> <p>This Agreement has been reviewed and approved as to form and legal content by the Office of the General Counsel.</p>

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
