


EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

**Approve the termination of the Second Amendment to Interlocal Agreement between
The School Board of Broward County, Florida, and Broward County
for Joint Comprehensive Recycling Program**

Type of Contract:	Approve termination of the Interlocal Agreement Between Broward County and The School Board of Broward County, Florida for Joint Comprehensive Recycling Program effective thirty (30) days after receipt by Broward County of written notice, and authorize the Superintendent to transmit such written notice.

GENERAL OVERVIEW:	<p>On the 8/21/12 Board meeting, The SBBC did not approve the Second Amendment to Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the School Board of Broward County, Florida and Broward County for Joint Comprehensive Recycling Program; instead suggested the Energy Conservation Utility Management Department to bid out the recycling program for competitive prices. In the interim and to not interrupt the recycling services, on the 10/2/12 Board Meeting, The SBBC approved the Second Amendment to Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the School Board of Broward County, Florida and Broward County for Joint Comprehensive Recycling Program, with the understanding that the new bid had to be posted no later than March 31.</p> <p>Pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement Between Broward County and The School Board of Broward County, Florida for Joint Comprehensive Recycling Program (the "Agreement"). Article 5.2 of the Agreement provides that either party may unilaterally terminate the Agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party pursuant to Article 8.4 of the Agreement.</p> <p>This item terminates the Agreement effective thirty (30) days after receipt by Broward County of written notice and authorizes the Superintendent to issue written notice to Broward County in the form of attached Exhibit 2.</p> <p>Termination of the Agreement is recommended as a cost savings to the District as more particularly described on the attached Executive Summary.</p>
