

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Policy 5006: Suspension & Expulsion

Policy 5006, Suspension & Expulsion has been vetted through the required process outlined in Policy 1001, Rule Adoption and Rule Making. All recommendations have been considered and reviewed.

The current changes put forth for Policy 5006 for this final reading are listed on the Matrix of Substantive Changes.

Following are the recommended language changes:

B. Sale, Attempted Sale, and/or Transmittal of Authorized or Unauthorized Over-the-Counter Medication is prohibited.

- Deletion: First and Second Offense Procedures:
 - a. Upon committing the first ~~or second~~ offense, the substance shall be confiscated from the student. The parent shall be notified and the student shall receive a consequence as outlined by the Discipline Matrix (see Policy 5.8: Code of Student Conduct – Appendix A).
- Change: Third Second and Subsequent Offense Procedures:
 - b. Upon committing the ~~third~~ second and subsequent offense, the substance shall be confiscated from the student. The parent shall be notified and the student shall receive a consequence as outlined by the Discipline Matrix (see Policy 5.8: Code of Student Conduct – Appendix A).
 - c. The student shall be referred to the District’s Substance Abuse Case Manager.
