EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Policy 5.8: Code of Student Conduct

Policy 5.8, Code of Student Conduct has been vetted through the required process outlined in Policy 1001, Rule Adoption and Rule Making. All recommendations have been considered and reviewed.

The current changes put forth for Policy 5.8 for this final reading are listed on the Matrix of Substantive Changes.

Following are the recommended language changes:

- Deletion: Special event.
 - Examples of special events include important public functions, conferences, state/national competitions, <u>college/university campus</u> <u>tour/visit</u> as well as exceptional cases of family need. Students must get permission from the principal/designee at least 5 days in advance.

<u>B. Sale, Attempted Sale, and/or Transmittal of Authorized or Unauthorized Over-</u> <u>the-Counter Medication is prohibited.</u>

- Deletion: First and Second Offense Procedures:
 - a. Upon committing the first or second offense, the substance shall be confiscated from the student. The parent shall be notified and the student shall receive a consequence as outlined by the Discipline Matrix -Appendix A.
- Change: Third Second and Subsequent Offense Procedures:
 - <u>b. Upon committing the third second and subsequent offense, the substance shall be confiscated from the student. The parent shall be notified and the student shall receive a consequence as outlined by the Discipline Matrix Appendix A.</u>
 - <u>c. The student shall be referred to the District's Substance Abuse Case</u> <u>Manager.</u>
