Saturdays, Sundays, legal holidays and days during which the school district administration is closed shall be excluded in the computation of the 72-hour time period. Filings shall be at the office of the Director of Supply Management and Logistics Department, 7720 West Oakland Park Boulevard, Suite 323, Sunrise, Florida 33351. Section 120.57(3)(b), Florida Statutes, states that "The formal written protest shall state with particularity the facts and law upon which the protest is based." Any person who files an action protesting and intended decision shall post with the School Board, at the time of filing the formal written protest, a bond, payable to The School Board of Broward County, Florida, in an amount equal to one percent (1%) of the Board's estimate of the total volume of the contract. Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed by Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, or a failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes.
