Membership guidelines require that a majority of the members not be employed by Broward County Public Schools and that the membership reflect the diversity of the school's population. All SAC membership lists have been reviewed by the Office of Strategic Achievement, and have been approved as meeting the requirements outlined in the State Statute and School Board Policy. The primary focus of the SAC is to collaborate in the School Improvement Plan (SIP) process.
