SBBC Rationale for Not Participating In The Ms. Willie Ann Glenn Act Florida House Bill #227

History: The purpose of the law is to increase participation in the Summer Feeding Program in districts that do not make efforts to participate.

School boards <u>may be exempt</u> from participating in the act by including the issue on an agenda at a school board meeting that is publicly noticed, provides residents an opportunity to participate in the discussion, and votes to be exempt from this section. The district school board shall notify the Commissioner of Education within 10 days after it decides to become exempt.

Recommended Action: Vote to disapprove the Ms Willie Ann Glenn Act for Summer 2014
