**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF NATIONAL WOMEN AND GIRLS HIV/AIDS
AWARENESS DAY, MARCH 10, 2014**

WHEREAS, HIV/AIDS is a devastating disease having the greatest impact on women and girls; and

WHEREAS, Twenty-six percent of all new AIDS cases are attributed to women who have become infected with HIV through heterosexual contact and drug use; and

WHEREAS, Minority women represent a disproportionate number of those affected by HIV/AIDS, in particular African-American women between 25 and 34 years of age; and

WHEREAS, According to the Office of Women's Health, United States Department of Health and Human Services, community events and communication raise awareness of the increasing impact of HIV/AIDS on the lives of women and girls; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to empower women and girls by means of age-appropriate comprehensive sex education; and
