RE: Notice of Proposed Renewal of Charter School Agreement RSBM – March 17, 2014, Item L-15

Dear Mayor Ortis,

Pursuant to Section 1002.33(8)(b), Florida Statutes, the Sponsor shall notify the governing body of a charter school of the proposed renewal of its charter at least ninety (90) days prior to such renewal.

You are hereby notified that The School Board of Broward County, Florida, has authorized me to notify you of its intention to renew the Charter School Agreement existing between it and The City of Pembroke Pines, Inc., on behalf of Pembroke Pines Charter High School – 5121, for a fifteen-year period. Since you have elected to a renewal at this time, in order to coincide the term of the charter agreement with The City of Pembroke Pines Charter Elementary School – 5051, and Pembroke Pines Charter Middle School – 5081, the term of the charter agreement will commence July 1, 2014, and end on June 30, 2029. Attached is a copy of the Agenda Item and Executive Summary for your information. The Charter Schools Management/Support Department will provide you with the Regular School Board Meeting date when final Charter Agreement recommendations will be presented to the Board.

Per Section 1002.33(8)(b), Florida Statutes, you may request a hearing within fourteen (14) days of the receipt of this letter. The hearing shall be conducted at the Sponsor's election. The School Board of Broward County, Florida, has recommended any hearing process be conducted under the Division of Administrative Hearings that is available under Section 1002.33(8)(b)(2), Florida Statutes, in the event that a hearing should be required.
