SUBJECT: Capping of Enrollment

Coconut Palm Elementary's current enrollment is 1330. The fish capacity of our building is 1120 and with our four existing portables, the gross capacity is 1208. Therefore, at this time, we are 122 students above capacity and are registering between 6-10 students per day. The projected enrollment for the 2003-04 school year is 1573.

In order to relieve the overcrowding situation, capping the enrollment is being requested. Parents and community were informed that this request would be a continuation of the 2002-2003 cap, and that it is a temporary measure to relieve the overcrowding at this time.
