Project Description	In 2009, the School Board of Broward County entered into a seven-year agreement for the Destiny Library Management system for all schools. This Agreement also provided the Destiny Textbook Manager system for high schools and centers. The implementation of the Destiny Textbook Manager has resulted in better inventory control, ease of material distribution, cost savings and better time management for staff. The Amendment Three will expand the use the Destiny Textbook Manager system to all middle and elementary schools. Over the past three years, BCPS received over \$20 million dollars each year to procure instructional materials in both print and digital formats. The electronic management of these K-12 instructional materials, a significant asset to the district, is essential to effectively distribute, track and inventory these assets. The Destiny Textbook Manager will provide middle schools and elementary schools with real time reports to monitor their print and digital instructional materials inventory and licenses. These reporting features also allow schools to easily create and track textbook obligation and facilitates the transfer of instructional materials between schools caused by enrollment shifts and/or school restructuring. The Destiny Textbook Manager Reports track the value of the instructional materials inventory for schools and for the district and value of lost or stolen books. To meet the requirements of Broward Policy 6.5.00, each school is required to submit an annual inventory of their instructional materials. Using the Destiny Textbook Manager system elementary schools and middle schools will no longer submit their instructional materials inventories as individual spreadsheets. The annual inventories will be documented by a district-generated report, as is the current practice for high schools and centers. The Amendment Three to the Agreement will provide the bar code scanners, initial set of bar code labels, and implementation support to elementary and middle schools. This Third Amendment will
Evaluation Plan	District reports produced by the Destiny Textbook Manager will be used to determine the overall improvements in inventory control, instructional materials re-distribution caused by enrollment shifts and/or restructuring, and improved time management by school staff. STEM and Instructional Resources will monitor the implementation of the system.
