This amendment is entered into between the **Early Learning Coalition of Broward County, Inc.**, hereinafter referred to as the “**COALITION**” and **The School Board of Broward County**, hereinafter referred to as the “**CONTRACTOR**,” (“Amendment”) and amends the contract identified as **Contract # SBBC-RTCO-14-ELC4-3, Road to Child Outcomes**, Fiscal Year: July 1, 2013-June 30, 2014, between the COALITION and the CONTRACTOR (hereinafter the “Contract”).

**WHEREAS**, the CONTRACTOR has a renewal option under Section B of the Contract that provides for the extension of the Contract for a Term not to exceed a total of five (5) years.

**WHEREAS**, the original Term of the Contract expires on June 30, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the CONTRACTOR has decided to exercise its renewal option pursuant to Section B of the Contract and request an extension of the Term of the Contract for an additional one (1) year period commencing on July 1, 2014 and expiring on June 30, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 13, 2014, the COALITION’s Board of Directors approved the renewal of the Contract with a budget of \$943,157.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties desire to amend the Contract in order to conform to the renewal Term and reflect said action by the COALITION’s Board of Directors; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties additionally desire to amend certain provisions of the Contract to further clarify the responsibilities of the CONTRACTOR.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual terms, conditions, promises, covenants and payments hereinafter set forth in the Amendment, the parties to this Amendment hereby agree to amend the Contract as follows:

1. Page 1, Section B, entitled *Term* is hereby amended by deleting the phrase “September 2, 2013 and shall end on June 30, 2014” and hereby replacing it with the phrase “July 1, 2014 and shall end on June 30, 2015.”
2. Page 1, Section C, entitled *Contract Payment and Availability of Funding* is hereby amended by deleting the amount “\$827,894.00” and replacing it with “\$943,157.00”
3. Page 29, Section B.3.a. of Attachment I, entitled *Schedule and Description of Deliverables, Deliverables, Service Units* is hereby amended by deleting subsections (1) and (2) under said section and replacing it with the following: “(1) A unit of Road to Child Outcome services provided to approximately 15 child care centers, with a minimum of 72 classrooms, 550 families, and 936 children.”

4. Page 32, Section 4.a. of Attachment I entitled *Performance Specifications, a. Core Component Objectives (Outcomes and Outputs)* is hereby amended by deleting said section in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

**a. Core Component Objectives (Outcomes and Outputs)**

“The CONTRACTOR shall meet performance objectives, as measured on a semi-annual basis by the outcomes and indicators listed below. The COALITION and the CONTRACTOR shall jointly review progress on these Performance Objectives on a quarterly basis. Being out of substantial compliance with any one of these Performance Objectives may be cause for corrective action as outlined in Paragraph F below.

- (1) 80% of the preschool classrooms that score in the “low quality” range in any of the three (3) CLASS domains (Emotional Support, Classroom Organization, Instructional Support) at time of entry into the CLASS initiative will improve teacher- child interaction and move out of the “low quality” range after program participation as measured by pre and post CLASS observations conducted by reliable observers.
- (2) 80% of the toddler classrooms that score in the “low quality” range in any of the two (2) CLASS domains (Emotional and Behavioral Support, Engaged Support for Learning) at time of entry into the CLASS initiative will improve teacher- child interaction and move out of the “low quality” range after program participation as measured by pre and post CLASS observations conducted by reliable observers.
- (3) 80% of the infant classrooms that score in the “low quality” range in the CLASS domain (Responsive Caregiving) at time of entry into the CLASS initiative will improve teacher-child interaction and move out of the “low quality” range after program participation as measured by pre and post CLASS observations conducted by reliable observers.
- (4) 80% of the preschool classrooms will be identified as providing “high quality” Classroom Organization; 80% “high quality” Emotional Support; 30% “high quality” Instructional Support after program participation as measured by CLASS observations by reliable observers.
- (5) 80% of the toddler classrooms will be identified as providing “high quality” Classroom Organization; 80% “high quality” Emotional Support; 30% “high quality” Instructional Support after program participation as measured by CLASS observations by reliable observers.
- (6) 75% of the infant classrooms will be identified as providing “high quality” Responsive Caregiving after program participation as measured by CLASS observations by reliable observers.
- (7) 85% of children who entered the program below age expectations and remain in the program for at least nine months will show an increase their rate of growth (as evidenced by increase in level and/or maintenance of level within higher range of age band) in all areas of development when they exit the program as measured by Teaching Strategies Gold Performance and Growth Reports.
- (8) 85% of children who remain in the program for at least nine months will be functioning within age expectations in all areas of development when they exit the program as measured by Teaching Strategies Gold Performance and Growth Reports.
- (9) 80% of children participating in the program will “demonstrate” kindergarten readiness as measured by the Florida Assessment for Instruction in Reading (FAIR) and 50% of children participating in the program will “demonstrate” kindergarten readiness as measured by the Early Childhood Observation System Status Results (ECHOs).

- (10) No more than 5% of children participating in the program will score as "Not Yet Demonstrating" in kindergarten readiness as measured by the Florida Assessment for Instruction in Reading (FAIR) and no more than 8% of children participating in the program will score as "Not Yet Demonstrating" on the Early Childhood Observation Screener (ECHOS).
- (11) 90% of parents of participating children will indicate that the program in which their child(ren) is enrolled, helped them in their ability to understand and meet the needs of their children, as measured by an annual survey which looks at a minimum the following:
  - (a) Participation in school sponsored activities; knowledge of their rights and advocacy efforts on behalf of their children; how they helped their child(ren) develop and learn; access to services, programs and activities in their community."

5. Pages 53 to 63 of Exhibit A and Composite Exhibit B for Attachment I of the Contract is hereby amended by deleting Exhibit A and Composite Exhibit B in its entirety and replacing it with Exhibit A and Composite Exhibit B attached to this Amendment.

Except as modified herein, all remaining terms and conditions of this Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

All provisions in the Contract and any attachments thereto in conflict with this Amendment shall be changed to conform with this Amendment.
