REQUESTED ACTION:
 Approve the 2014-2015 SEAS program at schools and at the Broward Center for the Performing Arts.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:
 Since 1991, The School Board of Broward County, Florida, in partnership with the Broward Center for the Performing Arts, has presented the national award-winning Student Enrichment in the Arts (SEAS) program. The SEAS program continues to offer a unique style of learning by integrating theatrical performances in dance, music and drama into the student's education. SEAS brings to life storybooks and novels on stage. Each and every performance includes a study guide that links the performance to Florida Sunshine State Standards. Approximately 185 performances benefiting 133,226 students will take place in theaters and at schools during the 2014-2015 school year.


