

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The inter-articulation agreement between Florida International University and The School Board of Broward County, Florida will provide the opportunity for Florida International University dual enrollment courses to be offered on high school campus locations. Participating School Board of Broward County public high schools will provide an opportunity for students to engage in a rigorous curriculum that integrates core academics necessary for a – (4) year degree, while students complete a high school diploma. In general, the majority of the dual enrollment courses are only available to Juniors and Seniors, with the exception of those courses identified in **Appendix C** as opened to Sophomores.
