Carlisle's price offered to Calico Industries was a package of 5 nylon pads and was not clearly stated on the bid by Calico and could reasonably be considered as the net price per case. The miscommunication was between Carlisle and Calico Industries. Both companies are aware of this mistake and have taken measures to better communicate this information so this will not happen again. Item 32A/32B will be purchased from the alternate vendor, Genesis II.
