

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY
Surplus of Tangible Equipment
Board Meeting of March 15, 2005

Throughout the school year, Principals and Directors review equipment purchased for their locations and decide if the equipment is to be considered surplus, obsolete, uneconomical to repair or if there is no demand/use of the equipment. Through the use of the District's website, other District schools and departments can have items transferred to their locations before the items are declared obsolete.

A committee appointed by the Superintendent has evaluated the items listed and recommends surplus of these items. The Net Book Value of the items noted herein is \$1,160,950.86. The list includes buses, trucks, vans, cars and other miscellaneous items. Upon Board approval, the items shall be disposed of at a public auction.
