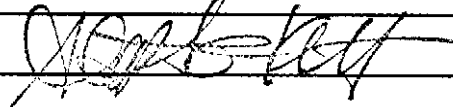
TITLE:	Revise Policy 1164, Communication and Public Engagement

Second Motion to Amend (Carried)

Motion was made by Mrs. Kraft, seconded by Mrs. Dinnen and carried, to amend policy, 4. Public Engagement Loop, first paragraph, to read, "The Public Engagement Loop has been designed for use only when a major initiative or new districtwide program is under consideration. The Superintendent, **or when directed by the Board,** shall determine which initiatives or programs are sufficient in scope and impact to require implementation of the Public Engagement Loop. This process shall take approximately 45 days to complete, starting with the District Advisory Council (DAC) meeting where staff begins the looping process." Mr. Rubinstein was absent. Ms. Gallagher was absent for the vote. (7-0 vote)
